Dear Sir.

Would it be possible to correspond with an investigator who would be able to appropriately advise on my accounts and witness to Contractor abuse in Afghanistan and gross negligence of certain ISAF staff and British Military Police?

This particular Contractor concerned is registered as a supplier of security services to the US Government with a Central Contractor Registration (DUNS: 561680427).

This involves..

Illegal weapons as deemed by ISAF and the Afghan MOI being used, stored, transported, and distributed by an Australian owned Private Security Company (PSC) operating in Afghanistan and the use of US and UK staff to illegally detain, keep incommunicado then Kidnapped and assaulted one of its own managers who is New Zealand National and retired military personal because he was attempting to report to the authorities accounts of illegal weapons, company abuse and illegal activities of the PSC and Safety concerning personnel, ISAF convoys and its forces, Taliban infiltration and a raft of other concerns in and near camp Bastion.

Gross negligence of ISAF and the British Military Police because instead of investigating, referred the matters involving illegal detainment, kidnapping and Assault, illegal weapons, Taliban staff and insurgents and illegal activities back to a civilian Logistic company who supplies NATO/ ISAF/ DoD with logistical necessities needed to maintain its operations but has no lawful jurisdiction and who

hires the specific PSC who are the main offenders.

This also involves a Military Technical Agreement which has frustrated the Authorities because the Contractors involved are unable to be held accountable for their actions and where the same PSC has previously been arrested and investigated for the same and similar offences 2007, 2009 and in 2010 was investigated by the US Armed Services Committee but what I encountered was the same but occurred Feb 2011..
